

520 Pennway – McQueeny Lock Building

About the Project

Located in the West Crossroads District at 520 West Pennway, this project involved renovating the historic McQueeny Lock Building to house three commercial tenants: Centric Project, Superior Bowen, and Inspired Homes. The overall design intent was to respect the original 1919 building features while providing a modernized feel to accommodate the needs of the commercial multi-tenants.

This \$6.5 Million renovation involved adding a new parking lot, a new entry promenade, a revitalized courtyard, and an enclosed roof deck with exterior deck and canopy that provides an amenity to all users in addition to an expansive view of the Kansas City skyline.
